

Equity:

The quality of being fair & impartial

Inclusion:

Practice or policy of providing equal access to opportunities & resources, especially those typically marginalized: minority groups, disabled, etc.



Inclusive Environment:

- Freely express opinions/points of view
- Feel safe from abuse, harassment, unfair criticism
- Feel valued & supported by instructor/classmates
- All expected to fully participate

Student-Centered Pedagogy: Equity & Inclusion Inclusive Environment, Achieved by:

- Using inclusive language: ex. don't say "guys" unless everyone there is male
- Model inclusive behavior & have an "awareness"
- Use diverse examples in different modes
- Highlight contributions by underrepresented groups
- Ask for multiple responses to a question
- Show that mistakes are opportunities for learning
- Be mindful when selecting groups
- Have scaffolding premade, available when needed




Instructor Approachability & Community of Inquiry

(Garrison et al., 2002)

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
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
