- 1. Ensure you know/follow your school's policy on use of AI (check their website and/or student handbook) - Librarians are also a great resource in knowing acceptable use of technology
- 2. Ensure you know/follow your instructor's policy on use of Al (check their syllabus, assignment instructions, and/or rubric) when in doubt ask.
- 3. Ask yourself if using the technology is helping you to understand the topic or simply doing the assignment for you, thereby negating the learning process that needs to occur within.

SUMMARIZE INFORMATION, *Prompt*: Please act as an expert article reviewer and summarize the article that I will provide. Be sure to give me the name of the article, the author, the date, the key point of the article along with its main points and conclusion. Do you understand?

- Don't abuse this ability! Some texts need to be fully read to gain deep understanding.

PREPARE FOR CLASSROOM DISCUSSION (Scenario), Prompt: Please act as a professor in a university professional communication course. Have a discussion with me by asking questions, one at a time, on the topic of teamwork. Ask about why it is important, how to build a team, how to avoid conflict in a team. and other similar aspects of teamwork. Do not answer for me. Let me give my response, give feedback on my response and then continue with the back and forth conversation. - Replace areen: your level/topic

STUDYING FOR A TEST, Prompt: Act as a biology professor and help me study the topic of Photosynthesis. Ask a question that would be likely to show up on a test about this topic. Ask me different types of questions such as True/False, multiple choice, and short answer. Ask me one question at a time and then let me answer before asking me another question. Ask me a total of 10 questions and then grade my response and give me feedback on what I still need to study. - Replace green: your level/topic

HELP IN LEARNING, Prompt: Act as a philosophy professor and explain Plato's allegory of the cave, but do it at a high school level instead of a college level. Be sure to provide lots of different examples to make it easier for me to understand. - Replace green: your level/topic/personalize complexity and adjust

WRITING FEEDBACK, Prompt: Act as a university writing tutor and provide usable feedback on how to improve writing composition. Use your rhetorical knowledge on effective writing techniques to suggest specific ways to best express thoughts and ideas through writing. Do not rewrite the document for me.

ALWAYS Critically Analyze ALL AI Answers!

Other ethical educational uses: help with creating a schedule, title for an essay, ask it questions to better understand, role-play, translation, etc.
